<u>Heb. 1:1</u> \P God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways,

<u>Heb. 1:2</u> in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world.

- 2 Tim. 3:1 ¶ But realize this, that in the last days difficult times will come.
 2 disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy, 3 unloving, irreconcilable, malicious gossips, without self-control, brutal, haters of good, 4 treacherous, reckless, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, 5 holding to a form of godliness, although they have denied its power; Avoid such men as these.
- <u>James 5:3</u> Your gold and your silver have rusted; and their rust will be a witness against you and will consume your flesh like fire. It is in the last days that you have stored up your treasure!
- 2 Pet. 3:3-6 3 Know this first of all, that in the last days mockers will come with their mocking, following after their own lusts, 4 and saying, "Where is the promise of His coming? For ever since the fathers fell asleep, all continues just as it was from the beginning of creation." 5 For when they maintain this, it escapes their notice that by the word of God the heavens existed long ago and the earth was formed out of water and by water, 6 through which the world at that time was destroyed, being flooded with water.
- Col. 1:17, 18 17 He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together. 18 He is also head of the body, the church; and He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that He Himself will come to have first place in everything.
- Rom. 8:16 The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God,

<u>Rom. 8:17</u> and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with *Him* so that we may also be glorified with *Him*.

<u>John 1:3</u> All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being.

<u>John 1:10</u> He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him.

<u>Col. 1:16</u> For by Him all things were created, *both* in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities — all things have been created through Him and for Him.

Eph. 3:9 and to bring to light what is the administration of the mystery which for ages has been hidden in **God who created all things**;

<u>John 1:18</u> No one has seen God at any time; the only begotten God who is in the bosom of the Father, He has explained *Him*.

John 14:8, 9 8 ¶ Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us." 9 Jesus said to him, "Have I been so long with you, and yet you have not come to know Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?

John 10:30 "I and the Father are one."

<u>Heb. 1:3</u> And He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power. When He had made purification of sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,

Col. 1:17 He is **before all things**, and in Him **all things hold together**.

Isa. 53:11 As a result of the anguish of His soul, He will see *it and* be satisfied; By His knowledge the Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many, **As He will bear their iniquities**.

<u>Col. 1:13</u> For **He rescued us** from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, <u>14</u> in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

<u>Col. 1:19</u> For it was the *Father's* good pleasure **for all the fullness to dwell in Him, 20** and through Him to reconcile all things to Himself, having **made peace through the blood of His cross**; through Him, *I say*, whether things on earth or things in heaven.

<u>John 1:29</u> ¶ The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!

<u>1 John 4:14</u> We have seen and testify that the Father has sent the Son to be the Savior of the world.

Acts 4:12 "And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved."
