Sunday, January 12, 2025 Sermon Scriptures

**Heb. 1:4** having become as much better than the angels, as He has inherited a more excellent name than they.

- Heb. 2:7 "YOU HAVE MADE HIM FOR A LITTLE WHILE LOWER THAN THE ANGELS; YOU HAVE CROWNED HIM WITH GLORY AND HONOR, AND HAVE APPOINTED HIM OVER THE WORKS OF YOUR HANDS;
- <u>Heb. 2:9</u> But we do see Him who was made for a little while lower than the angels, *namely*, Jesus, because of the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, so that by the grace of God He might taste death for everyone.
- **2Pet. 2:9-11 9** *then* the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from temptation, and to keep the unrighteous under punishment for the day of judgment, **10** and especially those who indulge the flesh in *its* corrupt desires and despise authority. ¶ Daring, self-willed, they do not tremble when they revile angelic majesties, **11** whereas angels who are greater in might and power do not bring a reviling judgment against them before the Lord.
- <u>Col. 1:16</u> For by Him all things were created, *both* in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities all things have been created through Him and for Him.
- <u>Phil. 2:5-8</u> <u>5</u> Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, <u>6</u> who, although **He existed in the form of God**, **did not regard equality with God** a thing to be grasped, <u>7</u> but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men. <u>8</u> Being found in appearance as a man, **He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.**

Heb. 1:5 ¶ For to which of the angels did He ever say, "YOU ARE MY SON, TODAY I HAVE BEGOTTEN YOU"? And again, "I WILL BE A FATHER TO HIM AND HE SHALL BE A SON TO ME"?

- **Psa. 2:7** ¶ "I will surely tell of the decree of the LORD: He said to Me, 'You are My Son, Today I have begotten You.
- <u>Heb. 1:6</u> And when He again brings the firstborn into the world, He says, "AND LET ALL THE ANGELS OF GOD WORSHIP HIM."

- **Heb. 1:7** And of the angels He says, "WHO MAKES HIS ANGELS WINDS, AND HIS MINISTERS A FLAME OF FIRE."
- Acts 2:33 "Therefore having been exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He has poured forth this which you both see and hear.
- **Phil. 2:9** For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name,

<u>Heb. 1:8</u> But of the Son *He says*, "YOUR THRONE, O GOD, IS FOREVER AND EVER, AND THE RIGHTEOUS SCEPTER IS THE SCEPTER OF HIS KINGDOM.

- <u>Heb. 1:9</u> "YOU HAVE LOVED RIGHTEOUSNESS AND HATED LAWLESSNESS; THEREFORE GOD, YOUR GOD, HAS ANOINTED YOU WITH THE OIL OF GLADNESS ABOVE YOUR COMPANIONS."
- <u>Heb. 1:10</u> And, "YOU, LORD, IN THE BEGINNING LAID THE FOUNDATION OF THE EARTH, AND THE HEAVENS ARE THE WORKS OF YOUR HANDS;
- John 1:3 All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being.
- Heb. 1:11 THEY WILL PERISH, BUT YOU REMAIN; AND THEY ALL WILL BECOME OLD LIKE A GARMENT,
- Heb. 1:12 AND LIKE A MANTLE YOU WILL ROLL THEM UP; LIKE A GARMENT THEY WILL ALSO BE CHANGED. BUT YOU ARE THE SAME, AND YOUR YEARS WILL NOT COME TO AN END."

Matt. 7:21-23 21 ¶ "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter. 22 "Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' 23 "And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.'

<u>Luke 6:46</u> ¶ "Why do you call Me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say?

<u>1 Pet. 5:8</u> Be of sober *spirit*, be on the alert. **Your adversary, the devil**, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.

<u>1 John 3:8</u> the one **who practices sin is of the devil**; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, to destroy the works of the devil.
