Matt. 16:13-17 13 ¶ Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, He was asking His disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" 14 And they said, "Some say John the Baptist; and others, Elijah; but still others, Jeremiah, or one of the prophets." 15 He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" 16 Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." 17 And Jesus said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Barjona, because flesh and blood did not reveal this to you, but My Father who is in heaven.

Matt. 26:72-74 72 And again he denied it with an oath, "I do not know the man." 73 A little later the bystanders came up and said to Peter, "Surely you too are *one* of them; for even the way you talk gives you away." 74 Then he began to curse and swear, "I do not know the man!" And immediately a rooster crowed.

<u>John 8:24</u> "Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for unless you believe that I am *He*, you will die in your sins."

<u>John 3:18</u> "He who believes in Him is not judged; he who does not believe has been judged already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

Acts 4:12 "And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved."

<u>1Cor. 1:9-11</u> 9 God is faithful, through whom you were called into fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. <u>10</u> ¶ Now I exhort you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, **that you all agree and that there be no divisions among you,** but that you be made complete in the same mind and in the same judgment. <u>11</u> For I have been informed concerning you, my brethren, by Chloe's *people*, **that there are quarrels among you.** 

Eph. 4:3 being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Gal. 1:6-9, 11, 12 6 ¶ I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him who called you by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel; 7 which is really not another; only there are some who are disturbing you and want to distort the gospel of Christ. 8 But even if we, or an angel from heaven, should preach to you a gospel contrary to what we have preached to you, he is to be accursed! 9 As we have said before, so I say again now, if any man is preaching to you a gospel contrary to what you received, he is to be accursed!

Gal. 1:11 ¶ For I would have you know, brethren, that the gospel which was preached by me is not according to man.

**Gal. 1:12** For I neither received it from man, nor was I taught it, but *I received it* through a revelation of Jesus Christ.

<u>Gal. 2:20</u> "I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

**Phil. 1:21** For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.

<u>Philem. 8-10, 17, 18</u> 8 ¶ Therefore, though I have enough confidence in Christ to order you *to do* what is proper,  $\underline{9}$  yet for love's sake I rather appeal *to you* — since I am such a person as Paul, the aged, and now also a prisoner of Christ Jesus —  $\underline{10}$  I appeal to you for my child Onesimus, whom I have begotten in my imprisonment,

**Philem. 17** ¶ If then you regard me a partner, accept him as *you would* me.

**Philem. 18** But if he has wronged you in any way or owes you anything, charge that to my account;

<u>Col. 3:13</u> bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.

1 Cor. 5:12, 13 12 For what have I to do with judging outsiders? Do you not judge those who are within the church?

## <u>1 Cor. 5:13</u> But those who are outside, God judges. REMOVE THE WICKED MAN FROM AMONG YOURSELVES.

**Matt. 7:1** ¶ "**Do not judge** so that you will not be judged.

<u>John 7:24</u> "Do not judge according to appearance, but judge with righteous judgment."

Acts 20:17, 28-32 17 ¶ From Miletus he sent to Ephesus and called to him the elders of the church.

Acts 20:28 "Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood. 29 "I know that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; 30 and from among your own selves men will arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them. 31 "Therefore be on the alert, remembering that night and day for a period of three years I did not cease to admonish each one with tears. 32 "And now I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified.

Phil. 2:3-8, 12 3 Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves; 4 do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others. 5 Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, 6 who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7 but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men. 8 Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

**Phil. 2:12** ¶ So then, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, **work out your salvation with fear and trembling**;

<u>James 3:1</u> ¶ Let not many *of you* become teachers, my brethren, knowing that as such we will incur a stricter judgment.

- <u>James 3:2</u> For we all stumble in many ways. If anyone does not stumble in what he says, he is a perfect man, able to bridle the whole body as well.
- <u>James 3:5</u> So also the tongue is a small part of the body, and *yet* it boasts of great things. ¶ See how great a forest is set aflame by such a small fire!
- <u>James 3:6</u> And the tongue is a fire, the *very* world of iniquity; the tongue is set among our members as that which defiles the entire body, and sets on fire the course of *our* life, and is set on fire by hell.
- <u>Matt. 15:19</u> "For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, **slanders.**
- **2** Cor. 12:20 For I am afraid that perhaps when I come I may find you to be not what I wish and may be found by you to be not what you wish; that perhaps *there will be* strife, jealousy, angry tempers, disputes, **slanders**, **gossip**, arrogance, disturbances;
- <u>1 Tim. 3:11</u> Women *must* likewise *be* dignified, **not malicious gossips**, but temperate, faithful in all things.
- <u>**2 Tim. 3:3**</u> unloving, irreconcilable, **malicious gossips**, without self-control, brutal, haters of good,
- <u>Titus 2:3</u> ¶ Older women likewise are to be reverent in their behavior, **not malicious gossips** nor enslaved to much wine, teaching what is good,
