Psa. 127:3 ¶ Behold, children are a gift of the LORD; The fruit of the womb is a reward.

Rom. 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Rom. 5:12 ¶ Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned —

<u>Job 19:18</u> "Even young children despise me; I rise up and they speak against me.

2 Kings 2:23, 24 23 ¶ Then he went up from there to Bethel; and as he was going up by the way, young lads came out from the city and mocked him and said to him, "Go up, you baldhead; go up, you baldhead!" **24** When he looked behind him and saw them, he cursed them in the name of the LORD. Then two female bears came out of the woods and tore up forty-two lads of their number.

Matt. 19:13, 14 13 ¶ Then some children were brought to Him so that He might lay His hands on them and pray; and the disciples rebuked them. 14 But Jesus said, "Let the children alone, and do not hinder them from coming to Me; for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."

<u>Titus 1:6</u> a namely, if any man be above reproach, the husband of one wife, <u>having children who believe</u>, not accused of dissipation or rebellion.

<u>Deut. 4:10</u> "Remember the day you stood before the LORD your God at Horeb, when the LORD said to me, 'Assemble the people to Me, that I may let them hear My words so they may learn to fear Me all the days they live on the earth, and that they may teach their children.'

Deut. 31:12 "Assemble the people, the men and the women and children and the alien who is in your town, in order that they may hear and learn and fear the LORD your God, and be careful to observe all the words of this law.

Eph. 6:4 And, fathers, do not provoke your children to anger; but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

<u>Titus 1:6b</u> namely, if any man be above reproach, the husband of one wife, having <u>children</u> who believe, <u>not accused of dissipation or rebellion</u>.

Eph. 6:1 ¶ Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. **Col. 3:20** Children, be obedient to your parents in all things, for this is well-pleasing to the Lord.

<u>1 John 2:15-17</u> <u>15</u> Do not love the world, nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

<u>16</u> For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world.

<u>17</u> And the world is passing away, and also its lusts; but the one who does the will of God abides forever.

<u>James 4:4</u> You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

<u>1 Cor. 6:19</u> Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?

Rom. 12:1,2 1 \P I urge you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.

<u>2</u> And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.
